As per the Hindu mythology it is the birth place of God Dattatray. Then all the students moved towards Renuka Mata, mother of Lord Parshuram. This temple is considered one of the three-and-half Shakti Peethas in the state. After taking lunch, students moved further to visit Ramgarh Fort, which is situated in front of the Renuka Mata Temple. The Ramgarh Fort is very ancient. It is assumed that this fort was built in the Yadav period. Lastly students visited Pandava Caves, which was carved in the 6th to 7th century during the Rashtrakuta dynasty. There are four caves in that place. There are five sculptures in the caves. All the students gained a first hand experience of the important historical sites and returned with good memories.





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Lecture on Article 370
